Support for the Foreign Missions

As per the diocesan Personnel Policy for Religious, a religious congregation present in a parish of the Diocese of Camden is allowed one fund-raising project each year in consultation with the pastor. The fund-raiser that the Missionary Daughters of the Most Pure Virgin Mary traditionally hold, at Christ the Good Shepherd Parish, is conducted within Bishop Schad School only. Each classroom conducts one mission project (bake sale and/or raffle). Of the total monies raised \$1.00 per student enrolls the students in the Holy Childhood Association here in the United States. The balance of the monies raised is sent to the mother house of the Missionary Daughters of the Most Pure Virgin Mary and is strictly used for the missions as follows:

- 20% Sent to the Vatican for World Missions
- 80% Used to support the missions of the Missionary Daughters of the Most Pure Virgin Mary, who minister to the indigenous peoples of Mexico, Nigeria, and Peru.

Parents cooperated in the benefit by contributing baked goods, when it was their child's class turn to sponsor a sale and/or by giving their child money to buy goodies. The sales were conducted over a 10 to 12-week period, as indicated on the monthly school calendar. We want to thank our parents who made this worthy fundraiser possible by their contributions of baked goods.
